



What makes explorers extraordinary?

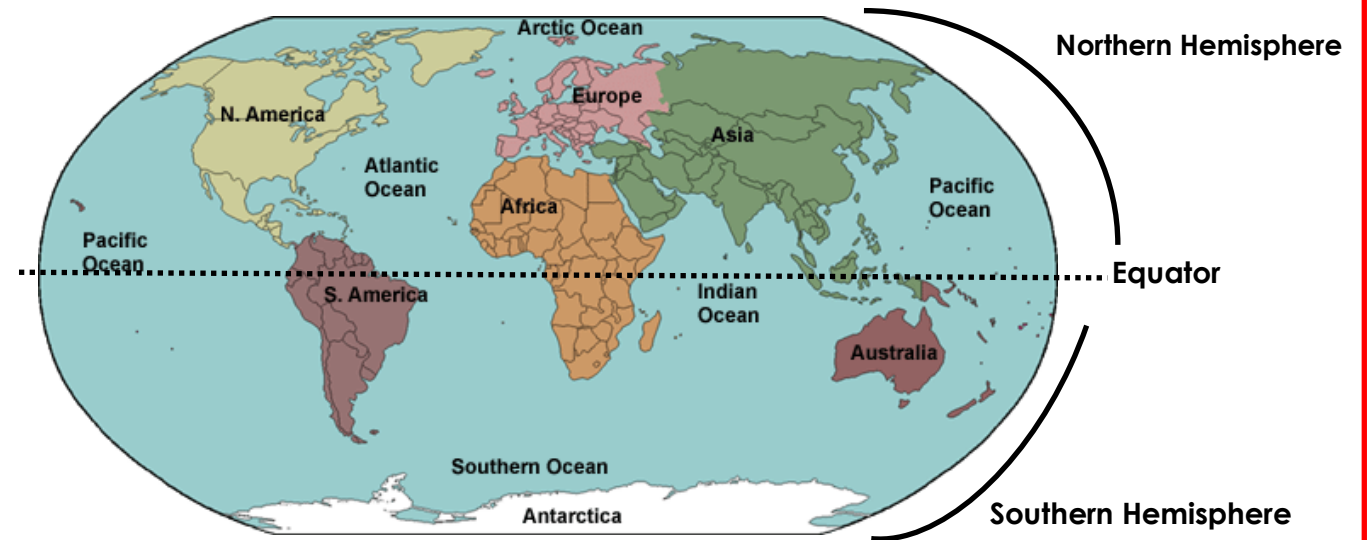


 Amelia Mary Earhart was an American aviation pioneer and writer. Earhart was the first female aviator to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean.

 Preet Chandi, known as Polar Preet, has the world record for the longest solo and unsupported polar expedition by a woman.

 Major Sir Ernest Henry Shackleton was an Antarctic explorer who led three British expeditions to the Antarctic.

 Speke and Burton led exploratory expeditions to East Africa to try to find the source of the River Nile. They were the first British men to discover Lake Victoria.

Ocean	A very large expanse of sea.

Northern Hemisphere	The half of the earth that is north of the equator.
Southern Hemisphere	The half of the earth that is south of the equator.
River	A large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea, a lake, or another river.
Poles	The two locations (North Pole or South Pole) on the surface of the earth
