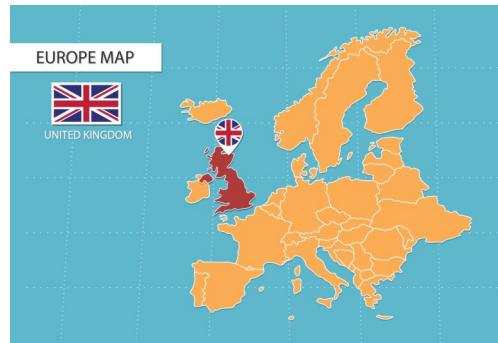


What do Kenya and the UK Have in Common?

Key Vocabulary and definition

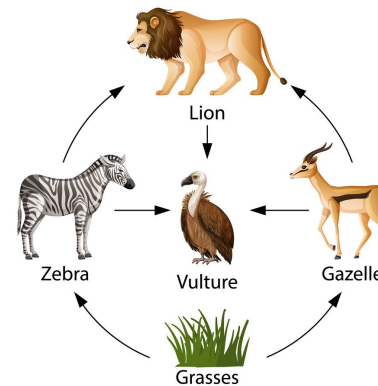
Food chain	A diagram showing the order plants and animals are eaten

The paper can be torn, crumpled or folded to create the desired effect.

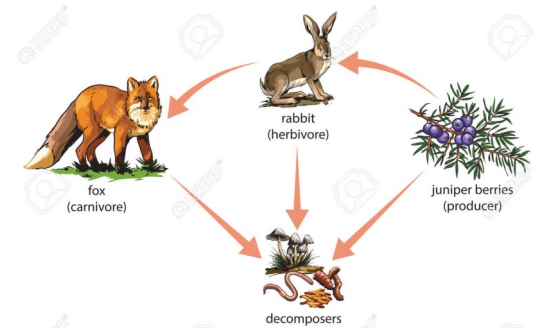
